I would confirm that the STUC Women's Committee will be holding a Weekend School on 'A Voice for Trade Union Women – Women into Public Life', to be held on Saturday/Sunday 31 August/1 September 2013 in the Novotel, Pitt Street, Glasgow. The School will be co-ordinated by members of the STUC Women's Committee, together with external speakers, and will incorporate speech writing, how to fill in forms when applying for roles in public life, together with general presentation skills.

For those who wish to attend the School on a residential basis, the cost will be £190.00 per participant (which is inclusive of VAT) and includes all tutorials, morning coffee, finger buffet lunch and evening dinner on the Saturday, plus overnight accommodation, and breakfast and coffee on the Sunday. The School will start at approximately 11.00 am on the Saturday and conclude at approximately 1.00 pm on the Sunday. A non-residential rate of £110.00 (which is inclusive of VAT) per participant is also available, which includes everything except bed and breakfast.

The closing date for applications is Friday 26 July to fit in with hotel cut off dates. If you wish to attend, please contact your trade unions or trades union council.

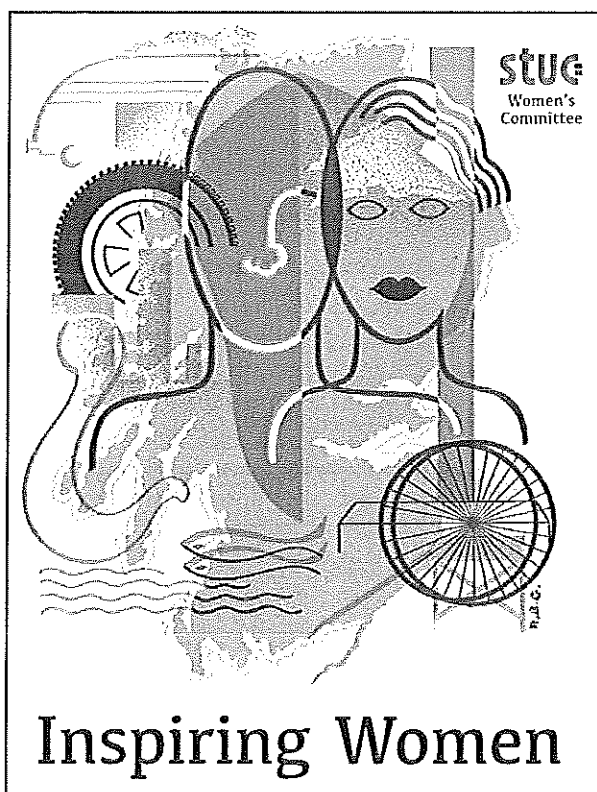
